
Sterling High School Winnie Brown Gym COVID 19 PROTOCOL

PROTOCOL

- •Coaches are required to self-screen their teams and coaches prior to entering the facility to ensure there are no fevers and have not knowingly been in contact with someone who has COVID-19. There will be a waiver to sign upon entering.
- •Players are <u>not</u> required to wear a mask on the court while actively playing but <u>are required to wear a mask</u> on the sidelines, in the bleachers, and anywhere else in the facility.
- •Coaches are required to wear a mask at all times unless they are drinking a beverage.
- •There will be designated areas for each team to sit.
- •Visiting team will have a single locker room area if needed for pre-game, but we encourage teams to come already dressed.
- •Six foot social distancing in the bleachers will be enforced. Tickets are all done online, please communicate with your parents that they need to purchase a ticket prior to traveling. Once the maximum amount has been reached, spectators will be turned away.
- •Spectators should take every precaution to wear masks at all times unless eating or drinking. We are asking that we utilize masks as well as social distancing.
- •No passes of any kind will be accepted
- •Players and spectators will have ZERO contact with each other. Players stay on one side, spectators on the other.
- •There will be no hand shaking before or after each game. A simple wave of acknowledgement will be our representation of good sportsmanship. Visiting team will
- •We will have water coolers available with designated student trainers to refill personal water bottles or cups. Please make sure your players are aware to bring their own bottles.
- •Visiting teams will have the restrooms in the locker room area behind the benches.

OFFICIALS


- •Officials will enter through the main doors in the Winnie Brown Gym. Masks are required upon entrance as well as a self screen.
- •Paperwork and sign in will be located at the main entrance with our "ticket taker." This will be the only time you may be crossing paths with spectators. Feel free to take the paperwork with you upon entrance and fill it out wherever you feel comfortable.
- •A coach will escort you to an office in the back, where you will be have an area to yourselves for the entire evening along with a private restroom
- •We will **RESPECTFULLY REQUEST** that a mask stays on throughout the course of the entire evening including during the game. We will provide Fox40 Electronic Whistles for your use. If this request would prevent you from officiating games, then we ask that you keep your mask on unless you are actively officiating a game. We would like to keep our table workers, players, AND officials all as safe as possible.
- •Officials may exit the gym at the end of the evening through the front doors that the spectators are not using. Escorts will be available if needed. You may leave the electronic whistles with the table workers.
- •We will have water bottles available for our officials.
- •If there is any special requests that would make any officials more comfortable, please feel free to contact us in advance.

Spectator Seating and Protocol






Lobby
